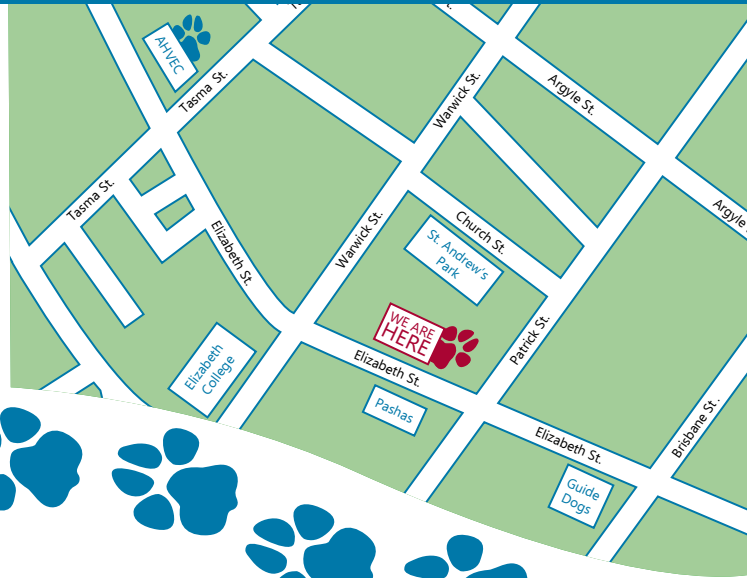


## North Hobart Veterinary Hospital

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## What Your Pet Can Expect

- To be handled with care, respect and compassion at all times, with a focus on their comfort and alleviation of any pain.

- To be given an opportunity to relieve themselves 3 to 4 times daily, away from their hospital bed where appropriate. If their bed or litter tray is soiled it will be cleaned as soon as observed.
- To be kept clean and comfortable regardless of their medical condition.
- Case management that is clear and well recorded.
- To have their owner kept informed of their condition and progress.

## Appointments

Consultations are by appointment only. Please contact us on 6234 7044 to make an appointment.

We know that your time is precious and we endeavour to minimise waiting times, but emergencies and critical cases will always take priority. We will try to keep you informed in advance of likely delays.

If you are unable to make your appointment time we would appreciate a call to let us know. If possible we may be able to rearrange our appointments to accommodate you, but in some cases we may need to reschedule.



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## Payment for Service

Payment is due at the time of consultation or upon discharge of your pet from hospital. We endeavour to accurately estimate the cost of our services and keep you informed of any changes. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, eftpos or credit card. Internet banking, direct debit and Vetpay may be available by prior arrangement.

We have ample off street parking and easy access through the automatic glass doors into reception. If you need assistance bringing your pet in from your car please don't hesitate to come in to reception and the staff will be more than willing to help.
